Corey Heath will be speaking in May on the proposals for 2016 tag numbers, and 2017 season proposals. In addition the staff management objectives proposals will be presented for public comment prior to going to the commission. This will be an abbreviated version of the Public **Big Game** meeting being held May 3, at Redmond HS, Community Room, 6-8 pm.

Our March speaker was **Mikal Moore**, with the **National Wild Turkey Federation**. Mikal informed us about **wild turkey** spring season starting 4/15—5/31. Hunters are allowed 1 Male or bearded turkey with a season limit of 3 legal turkeys. Tags are available through the end of the season. 2016 should be a good turkey year. Her presentation included the capturing of Turkeys in Mexico and their introduction to island habitats.

The speaker in April was **Dave Jarschke**. Dave spoke to us about Spring Bear hunting and had great pictures to share along the Snake River Canyons.

Treasurer's report

John Bambe, reported that, as of April 13, 2016 we have \$105,461 in the chapter checking account and \$386 in the mitigation fund.

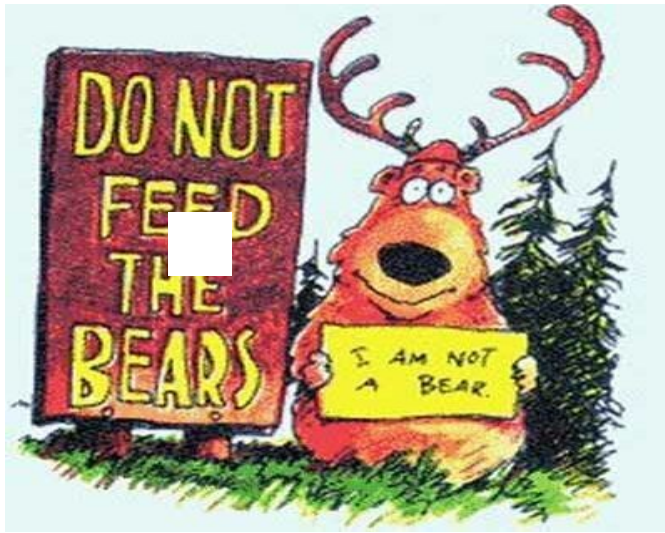

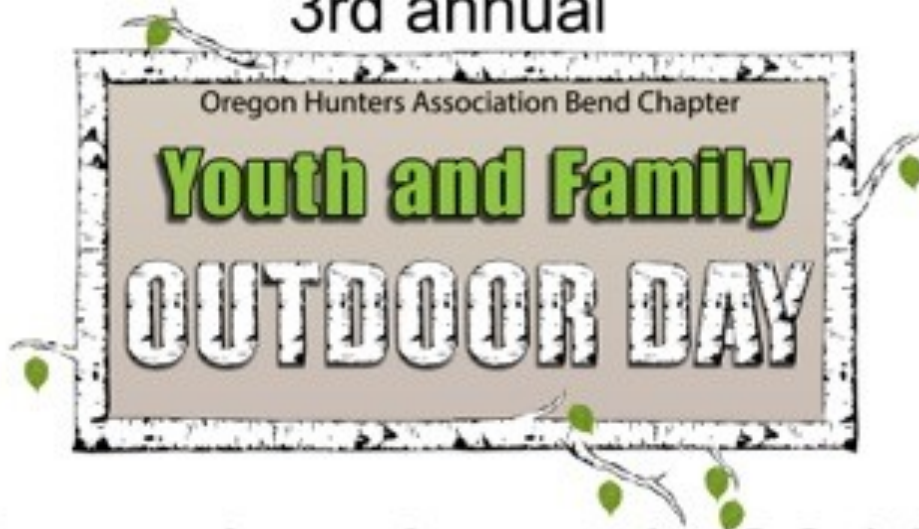
