Our speaker in December will be **Bryan Scott** with **Centerfire Gunworks**

The first speaker at our November 2 meeting was **David White** from OSU 4-H Youth Development– Shooting Sports. David spoke to us about the contributions OHA donated last year and how it benefited the group of young adults learning and competing in the shooting sport events. The state contest event was a hit and included students from ages 9 to 19.

The 4-H development program teaches shooting skills and "safe and responsible use of firearms." The 4-H Youth Development Shooting Sports Program is seeking future donations to continue the education and funding to hold state competitions and to help winners travel to national competitions. Volunteers are needed to help with the events too, so if you'd like to attend and be a part of the festivities, it would be appreciated. Our second guest speaker was **Anthony Spitzack**, from the USFS-Ochoco National Forest.

Anthony spoke to us about a joint USFS/Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation project that he is working on. The project is to remove young junipers from an area used for winter range and elk calving grounds. The object is to restore the area so elk and deer will come back. Junipers can use between 40-80 gallons of water a day, robbing the water needed for vegetation and mature trees. The projected project includes 2000 acres of small junipers that need to be removed

This project will be done in two phases including removing small trees, jackpot burning, rebuilding troughs, and building temporary fencing for springs, seeps and riparian areas. The project is adjacent to private land and owners are in full support of this project. OHA will consider taking this project on. If approved, OHA volunteers will be needed.





The Presidents Report

The Bend Chapter currently has 420 members, up from 418, as of the last meeting. Our chapter president, **Bill Littlefield**, would like to encourage all members to invite someone to join or just invite them to participate in one of our many chapter activities. Treasurers Report

Treasurer **John Bambe**, reported the OHA Bend Chapter has a current balance of \$69,778.00 in the checking account.









Dr. David White presented a short program on *Positive Youth Development through the Safe and Responsible Use of Firearms and Archery Equipment.* With a focus on positive youth develop through education, recreation, and competition, the 4-H Shooting Sports Program is the fastest growing project area across the nation. There are nearly 425,000 youth enrolled in archery, hunting skills, muzzle loading, pistol, rifle, shotgun, and western heritage. Oregon enrolls close to 2,000 youth and over 435 adults. Deschutes County enrolls close to 100 youth and 10 adults.

Sparked by an interest in firearms, youth learn about the safe and responsible use of firearms through mentoring provided by highly trained and caring adults. Many youth stay enrolled in the 4-H Shooting Sports Program for 10 years. This level of engagement in high quality 4-H settings set the stage for positive youth development.

By expanding the hunting, communications, and western heritage divisions, Dr. White has an ambitious goal to enroll 5,000 youth in the statewide program by 2020.
