Thank you for your interest in leaving a lasting gift to Oregon's hunting heritage through OHA's Legacy Program. If you decide to leave a gift, the provisions in your Will for making a gift to Oregon Hunters Association will depend upon the type of gift and your own circumstances. Our office can provide the legal language to assist in completion of the donation type and preferred designation for the gift.



You may consider some of these options for donation types and opportunities:

- An unrestricted gift for the general purposes of the organization.
- The creation of a Memorial Fund in your name and for a specific purpose.
- Specific donation to established funds such as the Youth Heritage Fund, Wildlife Fund, or Hunters' Victory Fund.
- Donation of a specific legacy such as property, art, or firearms.
- Designation of OHA as a residual or contingent recipient of your estate.



For members and supporters who wish to name Oregon Hunters Association in their will or estate plan, we should be named as: 'Oregon Hunters Association a nonprofit corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, with principal business address of 804 Bennett Ave., PO Box 1706, Medford, OR 97501'.

Oregon Hunters Association is tax exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

At Oregon Hunters Association all unrestricted charitable gifts are used strategically to support top conservation priorities.
