Seasonal Crew Leaders for COYCC summer program

Local non-profit Heart of Oregon Corps is hiring crew leaders to lead young people ages 16-18 in our 8 week summer jobs program - **Central Oregon Youth Conservation Corps.**

DUTIES:

- Work outdoors completing conservation projects with the US Forest Service on public lands
- Train, supervise, & mentor young people (16-18) from a wide variety of backgrounds
- Ensure crew safety and productivity
- Plan logistics of projects in coordination with USFS sponsor including travel, equipment, & communications
- Operate, maintain, clean, and inventory equipment, including power tools, hand tools, and vehicles



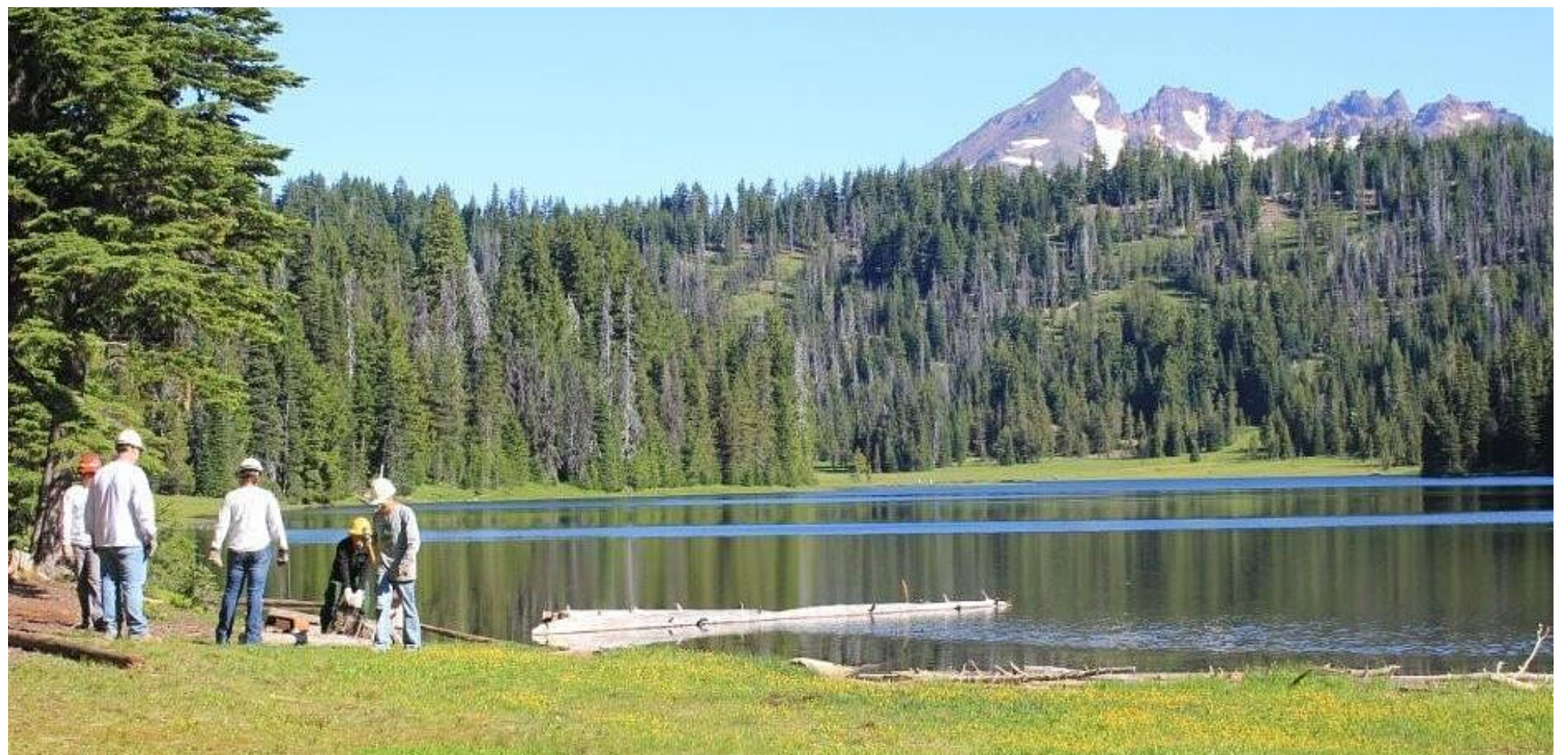
DETAILS:

- **Physical Requirements:** Heavy work. Exerting 25-50+ pounds, walking, pushing, pulling, bending. Operating vehicle, power equipment, and hand tools. Extended periods of outdoor exposure.
- **Status:** Temporary, Full-Time, Non-Exempt
- **Wage:** \$16.25 an hour
- **Locations:** Crescent, Prineville, Bend, Redmond, Madras, Sisters, and Warm Springs
- **Schedule:** Must be able to work the entire season. Crew leader training M-F, 6/15/20 - 6/19/20, work season is M-Th, 6/22/20 - 8/13/20.
