Leland spoke on what lead is doing to our environment and how it causes sickness in birds and fish feeding on it then it trickles up the food chain to our bigger wildlife and of course, humans. It's amazing that you can make a huge difference, simply by switching over to non-lead ammunition.

Leland Brown, has directed the Non-lead Hunting Education Program at the Oregon Zoo since 2015. An avid outdoorsman, he works to build collaborative partnerships between hunting and non-hunting conservation communities to increase the use of nonlead ammunition. Leland helped found the North American Non-lead Partnership in 2018, to maintain our wildlife conservation and hunting heritage. He has worked as a wildlife biologist in a number of diverse ecosystems, with particular focus on invasive species management, landscape conservation, and endangered species recovery programs. Leland hunts whenever he can.
