November Meeting Recap

In case you were unable to attend our monthly meeting at Big E's on Nov 13th, here are a <u>few</u> highlights:

Our guest speaker was Brett Michalski, who has been a COCC professor for 31 years. During his enthusiastic presentation, he shared his background of growing up in a hunting/fishing family and studying wildlife management. He described some of the available courses: Forest Resources Technology, Wildlife Conservation, as well as the newest course of which he is especially passionate, Hunting in Modern Society. The course shares the role of hunting in modern society and wildlife conservation. There is an increase in the interest in hunting for food rather than just for a trophy. A goal of this course is to reach a group of kids who did not grow up with hunting, to give them knowledge so they can think critically and ask pertinent questions pertaining to hunting. This course is not designed to teach hunting but rather to foster interest in pursuing hunting and facilitate a positive experience. His enthusiasm was contagious and he left us all with the desire to take one of his courses.

Since **Kevin Borst** was gone on his elk hunt, **Wendy** gave a brief report on the Youth Upland Bird Hunt in October. There were 28 hunters, of which about 1/2 were new attendees. We had 30 volunteers! Two hunters harvested all 5 of the birds (2 pheasants and 3 chukar were planted for each hunter before their hunt).

The membership voted to approve the \$700 request to fund the T-shirts and hoodies for the new LaPine Hawks Archery team, who will be competing on the new Oregon High School Archery League.

Thank you to **Greg Farfaglia** at the Wallow Bar and Grill in Sunriver for his \$1100 donation!

Monty Gregg, wildlife biologist, presented a fund request for the Winter Range Restoration Project. The final phase is to finish planting 29,000 bitterbrush seedlings. There is a funding deficit of \$9,000 to cover the planting contract. The membership voted to give \$3,000 now and potentially the full \$9,000 pending board approval.





November 15, 2024

Lava Butte to Vandevert was patrolled today with minor maintenance being conducted. A couple of trees were cut off the fence, top caps reconnected to the angle bracing and some brush cut on the ATV path that we use.

At the south end it was apparent since our last patrol that somebody has done some repair work. Fence wire was coming apart where two rolls had been connected together and that was repaired along with a few missing nuts and bolts in the angle bracing that were back in place.
