

March Meeting Recap

In case you were unable to attend our monthly meeting at Bend VFW on March 12th, here are a <u>few</u> highlights:

Our guest speaker was Andy Hamilton, ODFW Hunter Recruitment Specialist. He reminded us of R3: recruitment, retention, reactivation. His focus is hunter recruitment, by teaching hunting skills and shooting sports. These classes and workshops are skill based and species specific. He recommends that a new hunter begins with the shotgun because that would give them the most opportunity with the longest seasons. This program is created for adults who are new to the sport, want to learn a new aspect of the sport, are trying to get back in to the sport, etc. There are also opportunities for volunteers to get involved in the program: pass on your knowledge and passion as a Shooting Sports Instructor, Adult Hunter Mentor, or Event Support Specialist. Here are some of the ODFW Hunter Recruitment Workshops:

Hunting Skills classes: Shotgun Skills, Bowhunters Skills, Rifle Skills, Glassing and Observation

How to Hunt: Turkey, Waterfowl, Upland, Introduction to Hunting in Oregon

Besides classroom time, there is the opportunity for hands-on learning, including hunting scenarios with targets and sporting clays. There is even a mentored hunting opportunity to hunt problem turkeys, as well as an early am duck hunt after the waterfowl class. Classes are posted about a month out on the ODFW website. (good luck navigating that website!)

He asked us to spread the word because not everyone knows about this incredible opportunity.

John Bambe reported that we had another sold-out, successful banquet. We may have set a new Bend Chapter record. He'll have more details for us at the April monthly meeting. Our Youth & Family Outdoor Day will be Saturday May 31. Online registration begins April 15th and runs through Memorial Day. **Kevin Borst** passed around a sign-up sheet for volunteers. He'll bring it to the April meeting as well.

If you would like to nominate anyone for the Annual State Awards, please get those to **Rex** by April 16th.

High Lakes Church SALT Student Ministries has requested \$4,000 to assist with their outdoor activities program. They introduce kids to hunting and actually take them out on hunts. We are working on getting the leader and/or actual student participant to explain the program and share their experiences with us at a monthly meeting.


Bend Chapter OHA Charles L Beckley Scholarship



Bend Chapter Volunteer of the Year 2024




Bill Littlefield, Bill Beckley, Eric Brown
